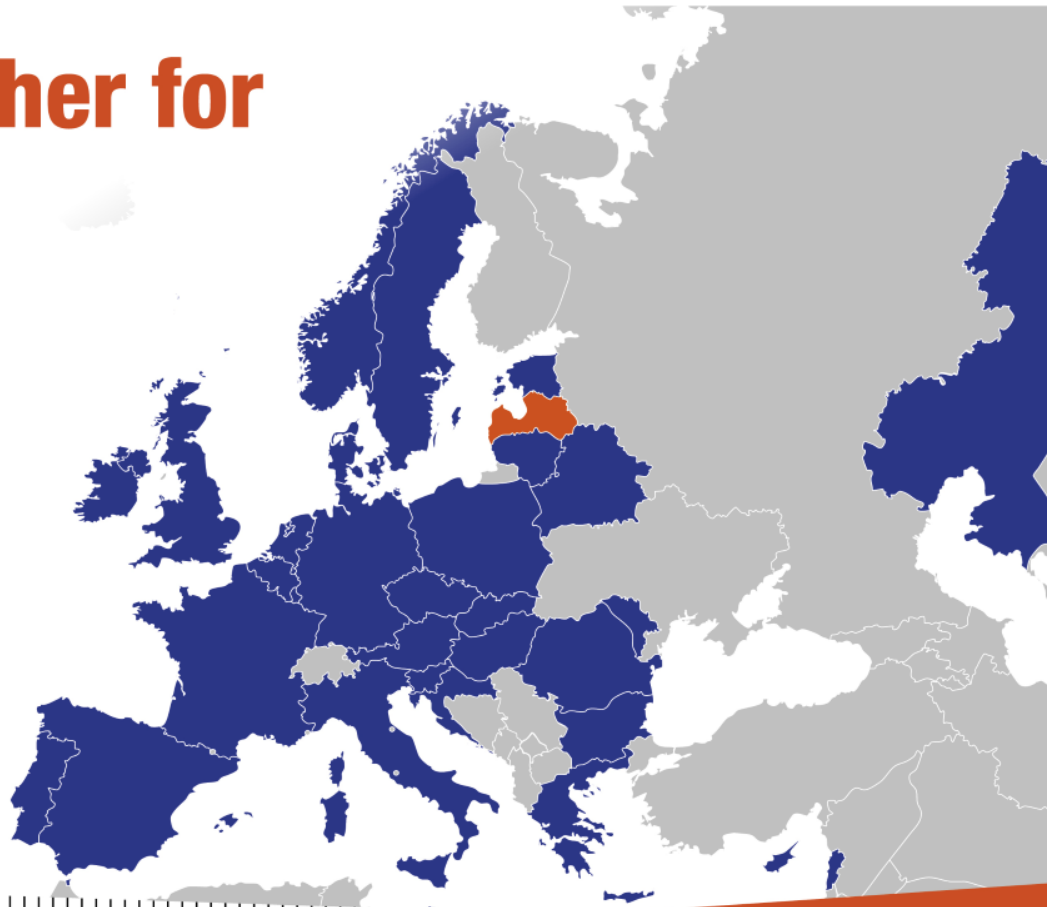
- Annual campaign organized by TE to engage and empower people to use technology and the Internet
